1. To discuss storeroom problems and agree actions.

The Clerk gave an account of the problems she was having with the storeroom and advised that she had put up a plan showing where the equipment should be placed. 2. To note and consider estimate for Gutter Clearing

The Clerk had obtained a quote of £125 to clear the buildings gutters from a local trusted and recommended source. It was agreed that this should be done asap due to problems which were starting to arise.

3. To discuss Hall Lighting and agree actions going forward.

Cllr Sheriff had done some research on various types of tubes suitable for the main hall, he presented his table which detailed two sets of tubes

5. To discuss and complete the initial draft Hall revenue and capital budgets for 2025-26
