Cremated remains internment (no charge if at the same time as a burial)	£490
New ashes plot in Garden of Remembrance (includes Plaque)	£525
Surcharge for American casket	£100
Scatter Ashes in Rose Garden (includes Plaque)	£65
Memorial Bench (includes Plaque)	£1500
